

**How do I get a TISAX label?**

You will need to register with [ENX.com/TISAX](https://enx.com/TISAX), prepare for, and complete an audit of your information security program.

**Where can I learn more about TISAX?**

Visit [ENX.com/TISAX](https://enx.com/TISAX) to learn more about TISAX. ENX's website has information about registering, selecting an audit provider, and preparing for your audit, along with a plethora of other information about TISAX.

**When do I need to obtain my TISAX label(s)?**

For all new work or contacts awarded starting in Q3 2026, you will need to adhere to our TISAX certification requirements. It can take up to, or more than a year to obtain a TISAX label. Preparing for a TISAX audit can be a large undertaking, so do not delay your registration and begin preparing immediately.

**My company has multiple locations that provide services to Stellantis, does each location need to be TISAX certified as applicable?**

Yes, all locations that provide services and/or are contracted with Stellantis must adhere to our TISAX certification requirements. ENX does offer a multi-location approach, and this is acceptable to Stellantis.

**Will alternative certifications be accepted instead of TISAX?**

No, starting from Q3 2026, a supplier needs to have a valid TISAX label in line with the requirements listed in the table above. Obtaining such a TISAX label should not be difficult if you are already ISO27001 certified or have a similar certification.

**Who will bear the costs associated with being TISAX certified?**

Any costs related to the achievement and maintenance of TISAX certification will be the responsibility of the supplier. STellantis will not be responsible for any costs.

**Which ENX participant ID does Stellantis have?**

Stellantis’ participant ID at ENX is **PLVFH0**. You will need it to share your TISAX label with Stellantis in the ENX database.

**Do I need to send any report or document about the TISAX audit to Stellantis?**

No, there’s no need to send any documents. It is sufficient to allow Stellantis (participant ID **PLVFH0**) to see the outcome of your TISAX assessments in the ENX database.

**How do I compute the Average Daily Production (ADP)?**

For direct material suppliers, the Average Daily Production (ADP) is the number of vehicles that Stellantis builds on average per day with your parts/material included. It can be computed as follows: For your production site, take the annual production volume of the carlines in which your part/material is included, add the numbers up if there’s more than one carline, and then divide the result by 235, to come up with a daily value. The result is the ADP for this site.

**How do I determine what Stellantis Global Material Group Code is relevant to the services we provide Stellantis?**

It is the responsibility of the supplier to understand the services they provide Stellantis and the corresponding Stellantis Group Material Code. Talk to your Stellantis purchasing representative or business partner(s) if you need to verify either aspect.

**I understand my TISAX label requirement, but what Assessment Level (AL) is required?**

The following table shows the minimum AL required for each of the TISAX Labels relevant to Stellantis:

TISAX Label	Minimum Assessment Level (AL)
Very High Availability	AL3
High Availability	AL2
Information with High Protection Needs	AL3

**Which TISAX Auditors do Stellantis require?**

Any Auditor that is certified through the ENX/TISAX process is acceptable by Stellantis.
